



Join the Ashland Chess Academy! Fall 2019 Information



The Ashland Chess Academy is a free kids' chess club program of South Shore Chess, a 501c(3) non profit educational organization. The chess club provides kids with a sound foundation in chess and opportunities to practice and play games with peers each week.

Chess Club will be held every Thursday from 4:00 pm to 5:30 pm, except for holidays at the Ashland Library beginning October 3. Chess Club is tentatively scheduled to end on November 14, 2019 based on coaching and parent availability. The club will be coached by experienced US Chess Federation rated chess players including older students and parents at times.

Parents must complete the registration form (see next page). The registration form can be emailed or brought to the first session, but a student cannot participate in the chess club without proper registration.

- Club Procedures: The chess club meets in the Ashland Library at 4:00PM. Kids will receive a snack at the beginning and then we will begin with instruction and games of chess.
- Parents should pick their child up in the library promptly (between 5:25 and 5:30) unless they give written permission otherwise.
- Attendance and Behavioral Expectations: We strongly encourage children to make a commitment to attend all possible weekly meetings. The chess instruction builds from week to week so it is important for children to have the background from previous weeks. We expect children to be attentive (and not disruptive) during meetings. Parents will be notified if discipline is a problem.
- Parent Involvement: The Club strongly encourages parent involvement. Parents help with snacks, distribute chess boards, and keep order during the meetings (experience with chess is not required). Additional information will be sent via email regarding volunteer sign-up.
- Tournaments: Tournament participation is encouraged, but not required. The tournaments provide an opportunity to play against age-matched peers.
